Safety Instructions

*Please read carefully.

- OInstall Magnet Light Stand on a level surface according to this manual.
- Make sure that there is no foreign material such as gravels and sands between Magnet Light Stand and an aquarium tank. If any foreign material is caught, there is a risk that the aquarium tank may crack.
- To prevent an aquarium tank from falling down, keep out of reach of children.
- ODo not use this product outdoors because it may cause corrosion and rust, and the durability may be reduced.
- OCannot be used for marine aquariums.
- ODo not alter this product and use it forcibly in unreasonable ways.
- OAQUARIUM USE ONLY

Installation method

- Make sure to install Magnet Light Stand on a stable surface. Do not install this product on unstable places.
- Olnstall this product as shown in the illustration on the right. Place a Neo Glass Air tank on the stand. Then put the power supply cord of the Magnet Light G through the hole located on the back of the stand and install the light. (Neo Glass Air and Magnet Light G are not included in this product.)

Magnet Light Stand Compatible Tank Size

- Magnet Light Stand 15H: Neo Glass Air W15xD15xH25 (cm), W15xD15xH30 (cm), Glass Pot SHIZUKU
- Magnet Light Stand 20L: Neo Glass Air W20xD20xH20 (cm), Glass Pot SHIZUKU
- Magnet Light Stand 20H: Neo Glass Air W20×D20×H30 (cm), W20×D20×H35 (cm)

IMPORTANT

OThis Product cannot be installed in below places:

- · Places often having vibration.
- Places in direct sunlight, or having extremely high or low levels of humidity, or outside.
- · Places with extreme temperature changes such as near an air conditioner or heater.
- · Near home electric products (there is a risk for receiving an electrical shock in case aquarium water spills on them).
- OWhen Magnet Light Stand is wet with water, immediately wipe it off with a dry towel. And when wiping off dirt, do not use any detergent to avoid the paint to come off, but gently wipe off with a dry towel or a damp towel after wringing it out.
